Marine Corps History

NOVEMBER - DECEMBER

10 November 1921 First formal commemoration of the Marine Corps birthday. Major General Comman- dant John A. Lejeune issued Marine Corps Order No. 47 summarizing the history, mis-sion and tradition of the Marine Corps and directed that it be read each 10 November to celebrate the beginning of the Marine Corps on 10 November 1775.

7 December 1941 On a peaceful Sunday Morning on the island of Oahu in Ha-waii, the United States was thrust into the war that they were trying to avoid. At just before 8:00 AM nearly 200 Japanese planes attacked the Airfields at Pearl Harbor followed quickly by another wave of torpedo bombers that attacked the ships that were anchored there. A total of nine ships were sunk, including the USS Arizona, and 21 ships were severely dam-aged. Over 2,300 Americans were killed in the attack and nearly 1,200 were injured. 15 December 1948 The Secretary of the Navy signed a "Memorandum of Agreement" with the State Department which laid the basis for the modern Marine Security Guard program at U.S. embassies throughout the world.
